

Referee`s Course

The Welsh Crown Green Referee`s Society (WCGRS) in conjunction with the British Crown Green Referee`s Society (BCGRS)S is running a course in the New Year subject to covid regulations.

The course will consist of a zoom meeting seminar on Tuesday 18th January starting at 7.00pm given by David Williams of the BCGRS explaining of the rules of bowls,

Referee`s duties, dress code and code of conduct. Maximum time 2 hours.

This will be followed by a written examination of twenty-five questions to be answered in 40 minutes with a pass mark of twenty-two, which you must pass before sitting examination two.

This will be held at Abergele B.C. on Saturday 29th January at 10.00am with a WCGRS Referee invigilating

Those who fail must wait 3 months before resitting the exam.

The second seminar will be a face to face with David Williams of the BCGRS and will be held at Abergele B.C. on Saturday 26th February at 10.00am for a maximum of 2hours.

This will be followed by a written examination with questions with varying points for your answers with a pass mark of 125 out of a possible 147.

This will be held at Abergele B.C. on Saturday 12th March at 10.00am with a WCGRS Referee invigilating

Those who fail must wait 3 months before resitting the exam.

When you have successfully passed both examinations you will be awarded your certificate, but you will not be able to officiate until you have passed your practical and green craft examinations

Which will be done by the WCGRS assessor at a match

There is a fee of £10.00 for the examinations.
